The topics are: (1) Structure/bioregulatory considerations; (2) Cellular proliferation and growth mediation; (3) Angiogenesis and tumor growth; (4) Receptor interactions; (5) Vascular and non-vascular tissue modulations; (6) Proteinase regulation pathways.

This satellite symposium is intended to review recent developments in the understanding of cellular events mediated by thrombin and other bioregulatory proteinases. Major emphasis will be placed on the post-clotting functions of thrombin and related processes mediated by proteinases in growth, wound healing and pathogenesis.
